Thank you to all our supporters and Coffeyville Area Community Foundation (CACF) for supporting the mission during the Coffeyville Matchday event! Our club was fortunate enough to come into 2nd place with most funds collected during this awesome event. Boys & Girls Club of Southeast Kansas received over \$30,000 and last week the foundation scheduled a check presentation to give the club our check for \$23,000 and the remaining \$7,000 will be deposited into our endowed account at CACF. CANEY'S SITE

This semester we received a donation from Juice Plus of our own tower garden. 3rd-6th graders were able to plant two kinds of lettuce, rainbow chard, kale and basil. Tower gardens grow plants 3x faster than a traditional garden and provide students the opportunity to grow their own food. They use as little as 2% of water as traditional gardens and recycle 100% of nutrients and water. Tower gardens are excellent for beginners, there's no digging or weeding.



Our summer program is set to begin May 30th and run until June 22nd. Our focus this summer is Stay Fit, Stay Healthy, Stay Sharp and Stay Safe. We will use our tower garden to learn about healthy eating habits and how to stay physically active this summer. We will also be keeping our minds sharp with math, reading, art, Spanish and sign language morning rotations each day. We have lots of fun activities and trips planned and can't wait to begin.

SUMMER PROGRAM

Our summer program is just around the corner! The Summer Program will start June 5th and run till July 28th. During these eight weeks our doors will be open Monday through Friday 7:30-5:30, breakfast and lunch will be provided. Every day our members will participate many different sessions while at the club. Some of our favorites are
Positive Action- a philosophy that reinforces that when we feel good about ourselves, we do positive actions.

Kidzlit- a reading enrichment program for grades K-5. Members hear fiction and nonfiction books read aloud and make connections between the stories and their own lives.

Summer Math- Members develop a sense of self-awareness and understand their schoolwork better with math programs that are in line with the school curriculum.

Art- Activities such as drawing, molding, cutting, and coloring require children to engage their minds in coordination with their hands thus reinforcing creativity, fine motor skills, and perception of shape and spatial relationship.

Sign Language- Interactive ASL lessons that enrich the whole child.

Team Building- Fun activities that help develop important life skills like problem-solving, listening, leadership, and creative thinking for all members.

Cooking- a hands-on learning opportunity for teens to learn easy meals to make at home.

Community Garden- Enrich academic learning opportunity for teen club members. Members will nurture relationships, and create a positive neighborhood environment that enhances their lives outside of school.

Along with all these sessions our members will participate in a number of different off site activities this summer. Activities like skating, swimming, Incredible Pizza, Discovery Lab and the Air and Space Museum are just a few places we will visit this summer! Our summer will surely be OUT OF THIS WORLD!

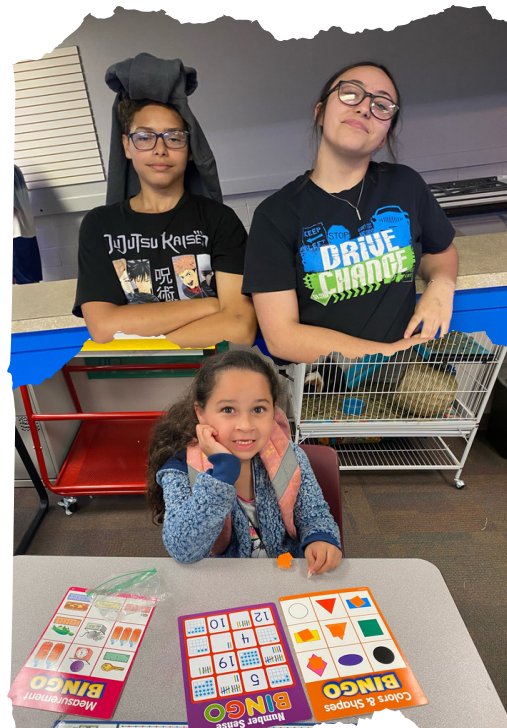
A PREVIOUS CLUB KID RETURNS TO COFFEYVILLE
