To create a Teen Site that empowers 7th and 8th graders to explore career pathways, excel in academics, and grow through sports training — building skills and confidence that prepare them for high school and beyond.

PROGRAM CLUSTERS

Career & College Readiness

- VR trade exploration, job shadowing, college visits, mentorships

TARGET AUDIENCE

Primary: 7th and 8th grade students in Coffeyville and surrounding areas

RECRUITMENT & MARKETING STRATEGY

A. Parent-Focused Messaging

Emphasize safety, structure, and success. Show how each cluster prepares teens for high school readiness and future opportunities. Stress that teens can choose one, two, or all three clusters. Key Parent Message Example: “Your teen deserves every opportunity to succeed. At the Boys & Girls Club Teen Site, we’re preparing students today for the leaders they’ll become tomorrow — through career exploration, sports training, and academic support. Give them the tools now so they’ll shine later.”

B. Student-Focused Messaging

Highlight fun, growth, and belonging. Use visuals, sports metaphors, and “level-up” language. Emphasize peer connection and hands-on experiences. Key Student Message Example: “Level up your game. Whether you want to crush it in school, sports, or planning your future, the Teen Site has your back. Join your friends and find out what’s possible!”

C. Marketing Channels
